Friday 3/19/2010

1. 8:00am – 12:00 Noon, Setup by Master Stanforth/Dan Rivera and setup crew.
2. 12: 00 pm, Registration and Set up continue.
3. 2:30 – 3:30pm, Officials Meeting- Referee/Coach/Committee
4. 3:30 – 7 pm, Competition begins for Self Defense, Weapon Forms & Padded Weapon Sparring, Synch. Form, Team Demo – Finalists compete on Sat. morning .See below for the details.
5. 5:30-7pm Workshops on Gumdo and WTF Forms
6. 8:30 – 11 PM after Event Dinner (BOC Leaders and their group) and networking at OMAC World Headquarters: 1349 Brice Rd. Tickets to the Dinner should be purchased in advance. They are \$15.00 per person; tickets can be purchased at the on-site registration if seats are available. Casual attire.
7. Finals for Synchronized Forms, Team Demo, Self Defense, Weapons forms and Padded Weapon Sparring will occur on **SAT. 3/20** at 11:30 after Opening Ceremony; this will be in Rings #3 & #4.

Saturday 3/20/2010

1. 8 am – 12 Noon On-site Registration for competitors, volunteers, referees, officials, coaches
2. 10 – 11 am Officials Meeting -Referee/Coach/Committee
3. 11-11:30am, Opening Ceremony – All participants line up on the CENTER RING AREA.
4. At 11:30, all competitors will report to **HOLDING AREA behind the bleachers** for competition regardless of when their particular event of competition begins. Competitors should remain in holding area as much as possible. Competitors will be allowed to warm up for competition in the holding area.
5. After a competitor has finished competition in a particular event, they **MUST** go back to holding area for next competition ring assignment.
6. 11:30 Breaking Competition Starts – All Competitors are required to be in the holding area.
 - a. Hapkido, Jujitsu, Karate, Kali, Kungfu, and Tai chi/Push Hands competition will begin at 11:30 am in their designated rings
 - b. Black belt Breaking/Form competition will begin in Ring #1 and #2 will begin at 11:30 am.
 - c. Best of the Best Competition/Demo will begin in Ring #3 and #4 will begin at 11:30 am.
7. 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM Form competition begins – All Competitors are required to be in the holding area.
 - a. Forms are **Double Elimination** (Loser has one more chance to be eliminated). Divisions with more than 16 competitors will be divided into two groups of 8.
8. 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM Sparring competition begins – All Competitors are required to be in the holding area. Electronic scoring will be used for Taekwondo Olympic sparring matches. Rules are posted on BOCworldgames.com.
9. 6:00 PM Tear down and clean up begins.
10. Each discipline leader is responsible for breaking down and organizing mats from their competition rings. These mats should be taken to the Drive-in Freight Entrance next to the registration area. This will really help the tear down committee finish quickly. Your help is greatly appreciated!
11. 8:30 – 11 PM after event- **BOC Recognition Dinner** and networking at OMAC World Headquarters: 1349 Brice Rd. , Reynoldsburg, OH 43068, 614-864-4000. Tickets to the Dinner should be purchased in advance. They are \$15.00 per person; tickets can be purchased in the registration booth if there are seats available.
